Margaret<sup>6</sup> Eliza Baldwin** (Alexander<sup>5</sup>, David<sup>4</sup>, William<sup>3</sup> H., John<sup>2</sup>, Warren<sup>1</sup>) was born August 1, 1865 in Columbus County and died March 20, 1951 in Columbus County<sup>40</sup>. She married Daniel Armelin Formy-Duval, son of Armelin Jefferson Formy-Duval and Mary Rebecca Shaw, February 28, 1888 in Columbus County. He was born January 10, 1862 in Columbus County and died April 23, 1934 in Columbus County. They were buried in the Pierce-Formy-Duval Cemetery, Columbus County.

**41. Wesley<sup>6</sup> O. Baldwin** (Alexander<sup>5</sup>, David<sup>4</sup>, William<sup>3</sup> H., John<sup>2</sup>, Warren<sup>1</sup>) was born April 1, 1867 in Columbus County and died December 13, 1949 in Columbus County<sup>41</sup>. Jr., William<sup>3</sup> H., John<sup>2</sup>, Warren<sup>1</sup>) was born April 18, 1874 in Columbus County<sup>45</sup>. He married Marietta Burney, daughter of Franklin Clark Burney and Lucy Powell Maulsby. She was born December 31, 1887 in Bladen County and died August 11, 1970 in Sanford, Lee County, NC.

**46. Amos<sup>6</sup> Vance Baldwin** (Dillon<sup>5</sup>, William<sup>4</sup> H. Jr., William<sup>3</sup> H., John<sup>2</sup>, Warren<sup>1</sup>) was born about 1877 in Columbus County<sup>46</sup>. He married Lucy Jane High, daughter of James High and Susan E. Brown, December 20, 1903 in Columbus County. She was born March 1883 in Columbus County.

**47. Leon Newton<sup>6</sup> Baldwin** (Dillon<sup>5</sup>, William<sup>4</sup> H. ## DOCUMENTATION

1. From Bacon, 2004: The earliest evidence of the Baldwin Family in Columbus County (Bath Precinct until 1729, then New Hanover Precinct until 1734, then Bladen County, and finally Columbus County in 1808) appears to be a 1727 deed written and signed by Warren Baldwin. In 1735, when the first land grants in Bladen County were being issued by the State, Warren Baldwin received 400 acres and his son, James, received 880 acres. Warren received an additional 1200 acres in 1739. All this land was on the White Marsh.

2. From Bacon: James is thought to be the eldest son of Warren. Rebecca was the 2<sup>nd</sup> wife of Sylvanus Wilson of New Hanover and Cumberland Counties. A Joseph Baldwin was listed in the 1790 Census, Bladen County, Captain Greene's District and the 1800 Census, Bladen County, Captain Barfield's District

3. From Bacon: Amy Bryan was probably the wife of John Baldwin. Thomas Bryan was granted land on the Brown Marsh in 1767. His LW&T, which was probated in 1767, named his daughter, Amy.

4. From Bacon: David Baldwin moved his family to Georgia in 1763. He served as a Captain in the Georgia State Militia during the Revolutionary War. William and Ephraim also have Revolutionary War records.
