DOCUMENTATION

1. Two Williamsons – John and Lewis – signed a 1779 petition to divide Bladen, Duplin and New Hanover Counties. At that time Lewis was a resident of Duplin County. I believe John was also. If he had to be at least 21 years old to sign such a document, he could not have been born later than 1758.

Marriage date from: Ingmire, Frances T., 1984, “Duplin County, NC, Marriage Records, 1775 – 1868”. Note that Aaron and Nathan named a daughter Nancy.

1800 Census, Brunswick County: Williamson, John – 1 male 10-16, 2 males 16-26, 1 male 45 and over, 1 female 45 and over.

Columbus County was formed in 1808 and included that part of Brunswick County west of the Waccamaw River, including the Seven Creeks Swamp area where John Williamson lived.

In the 1810 Census of Columbus County, there were two Williamsons, J. and A., not identifiable as descendants of Lewis and Mary Williamson. I assume these were John and his son, Aaron.

In a deed dated November 6, 1813, Aaron Williamson, Moses Williamson, Anne Williamson and James Rhodes (husband of a Williamson?) were listed as heirs of a 200-acre tract granted to William Williamson, deceased, except the cleared ground below the house as a “dower to our beloved mother-in-law in her lifetime”. Was Anne the widow of John and the mother of Aaron, Moses and William? Was she living with William at the time of his death and was to keep the house?

In the 1820 Census of Columbus County there was one John Williamson, “aged 45 and up” with four children less than 10 years of age. I assume this was John, II.

[3] Deed of Gift, John Williamson, Sr., to John Williamson, Jr., 50 acres on the south side of Bare (sic) Island Swamp. Wit. Wm Gore and Nathan Williamson, August Term 1837, (F-204/205/206). [4] June 10, 1839, Nathan Williamson sold to John Williamson, Jr., 100 acres for \$30, adjoining John Williamson, Sr. [5] November 20, 1840, 100 acres granted to John Williamson, Jr., adjacent to Jesse Ward.

Amelia Ward is not proven to be the wife of John Williamson. However, in 1814 a John Williamson who lived in the southern region of Columbus County joined the heirs of Thomas Ward to divide the Ward estate (Deed Book A, page 364). John appears again in Deed Book B, page 63, as a Grantor in the execution of another deed on August 4, 1815. From these papers we know that siblings of John Williamson’s wife were born as early as 1766 and as late as 1790. Thus Milly’s age would have been consistent with that of John.

A deed dated February 7, 1879, transferred two tracts of land previously owned by Aaron Williamson, deceased, to Henry Cannon Smith. Named heirs were: Alfred M. Williamson, Isaac Williamson, Nancy C. Williamson, King D. Hawes and his wife, Rebecca, Mc. C. Hawes and wife Rachel, Charles Tharp and wife Sarah. Aaron P. Williamson and Burrell Williamson were referred to as "deceased".
